



H₂OIL ALKYD EMULSION SOLID DECK STAIN

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

H₂OIL is the next generation of oil based deck stains combining the durability and UV protection of a true alkyd and the ease of clean up with water. A water repellent, completely opaque finish formulated to provide the maximum in fade resistance while withstanding moderate foot traffic.

RECOMMENDED USES:

For use on exterior wooden decks, railing and outdoor furniture. An excellent choice for coating over bare or existing stained deck surfaces.

PERFORMANCE INFORMATION:

One coat hiding over most surfaces. Excellent flow and leveling. Matte finish. Can be applied via brush, roll, pad or spray. Non-fading. Quick drying. Superior UV protection to prevent wood deterioration.

SURFACE

All surfaces must be clean, perfectly dry and in sound condition. Remove oil, dust, chalk, grease, rust, peeling paint and any other foreign material to insure maximum adhesion. Previously stained wood should be sanded to remove any loose or peeling stain. Should mold or mildew exist clean with Spore-No-More "Mold Remediator" via hand scrubbing or power washing. Allow to dry completely prior to coating. No special primer is required.

Application Data:

This product has been designed for brush, roll, pad or spray application. When spraying, back roll or brush immediately to avoid gloss build up. Stir product during usage. When spraying, test spray pattern prior to proceeding. Thinning is not recommended. Mixing with any other product is not recommended. Apply at temperatures above 50F. Protect from freezing.

Clean-up Information

Clean up equipment and area with detergent and water until clear water is visible.
